

PRESS RELEASE: August, 2009

The Castalian Springs-Bethpage Water Utility continues in the "APPROVED" category of Tennessee's public water systems. On May 20, 2009 the staff members from the State of Tennessee, Department of Environment & Conservation, Division of Water Supply, conducted the annual sanitary survey, which consisted of an on-site inspection and file review to evaluate the operational performance of your public water system. As a result of the inspection and file review, the Utility earned a score of ninety-eight (98).

All flushing records were reviewed to insure proper completion. Flushing the lines ensure good water quality for our customers. All bacteriological and analysis sampling records were reviewed. Water sampling is done monthly and quarterly throughout the District to ensure high quality drinking water. All seven water tanks were inspected as well as all pump houses. An additional Chlorine residual test was completed, over the daily testing required by the State.

This Utility has 3,794 water connections, serving a population of 10,016, with a average daily pumpage of 0.859 million gallons of water, and 1.53 million gallons of gravity flow storage capacity.
