On May 24, 2010 staff from the Division of Water Supply with the State of Tennessee, Department of Environment and Conservation, conducted a Sanitary Survey of the Castalian Springs-Bethpage Utility District. A Sanitary Survey is comprised of an on-site inspection and file review to evaluate the operational performance of the water system. The District has earned a score of ninety-eight (98). This places the water system in the "Approved" category of public water systems in Tennessee.

"The water system continues to maintain a high level in its operation and in record keeping. The water system and its personnel are to be commended for their efforts in obtaining an approved rating," stated Erich Webber, Manager of the Division of Water Supply.

"We are overjoyed. All the hard work from the staff is really paying off. When the State inspects and finds no major concerns it is time to celebrate. The customers of this Utility should be celebrating also," stated District Manager Bennie Oldham.
